We are celebrating a special milestone in 2023. For the past 50 years the Millbrook Rotary Club has been dedicated to "Service Above Self" in Millbrook and the surrounding communities. We were originally chartered on January 31, 1973 as the Central Dutchess Rotary Club, meeting at the Cottonwood Inn. As our club grew, we sponsored other clubs, including Pleasant Valley, LaGrange, and East Fishkill, all still thriving today, and we subsequently changed our name to Millbrook Rotary Club to reflect our close ties to the immediate community.

Over the years, Millbrook Rotary Club has sponsored and supported many events and projects, including the Millbrook Antiques & Crafts Show, Welcome to Millbrook signs, New Year's Eve Millbrook, and restoration of the monument on Rt 343, in addition to the publication of this annual community directory for the past 21 years. Today the club continues to serve the community by donating school supplies to families in need in several local school districts, supporting area food pantries (see page 3 for complete list), conducting seasonal road cleanups, and contributing funds toward the purchase of a new ambulance.

Supporting local youth is an important focus of the Millbrook Rotary Club. In addition to providing backpacks and school supplies, the club offers annual scholarships to local high school graduates, sends select sophomores to an annual leadership conference, sponsors the high school Interact service club, and for the past 30 years has sponsored outbound students from Millbrook to live and study abroad, and inbound students to study at Millbrook High, through the Rotary Youth Exchange Program.

Other club commitments include supporting global peace and health initiatives through the Rotary Foundation and the ShelterBox disaster relief program.

All in all, it's been a wonderful, dedicated, and productive 50 years. Please support the businesses who advertise in this book, the net proceeds of which fund the good works of Millbrook Rotary Club.



Community fridges are an example of what is called "mutual aid," a term that simply means people voluntarily help each other and share resources.


